Testimony

James Turnbull address the following concerns to the Committee

1. Crosswalks: people are not stopping for pedestrians in the cross walks, and Mr. Turnbull would like a program developed to encourage autos to stop for pedestrians using designated crosswalks.

2. Signage:Corner of Muncaster Highland Bjornstad has a yield sign that Mr. Turnbull thinks should be moved so that Highland street cars are required to yield to Bjornstead cars.

3. Fire hydrant on corner of Oslund and Young road has a junk car and scrap metal blocking access to the hydrant, creating an potentially dangerous situation during a fire.

4. Street legal vehicles: Valdez allows use of ATVs on their streets, why can't we do the same an effort to save fuel.

Action: Sgt. Wall will check on cross walk laws. Jan and Art will look at Muncaster situation.
